

Imaging Dementia—Evidence for Amyloid Scanning (IDEAS) Study

Request for Access to Images and Clinical Data

This application and attachments will be forwarded to the appropriate IDEAS Study Research and Publications Committee and reviewed through standard procedures as outlined in the IDEAS Data Sharing and Publication Policy. The IDEAS Study Data Access Coordinator will reply to you within two weeks of inquiry to alert you that your application has been received and is being processed.

The process for vetting applications for access to IDEAS Study data and images includes four main steps and would normally take up to 60 days to complete:

- 1. Applicant submits completed request form.*
- 2. The IDEAS Study Research and Publications Committee reviews the request.*
- 3. If the request is approved, an estimate of the cost for the preparation of materials and the timeline for fulfilling the request is developed and shared with the applicant.*
- 4. Work on fulfilling the request commences upon conclusion of the agreement with IDEAS Study.*

The timeline for fulfilling requests begins at the end of the vetting period and depends on the complexity and volume of the requested material.

CRF Data Step 1: Identify the CRF data elements you are requesting

1. Go to www.ideas-study.com,
2. In content area under either Referring Physicians or PET Facilities, select "Forms".
A PDF booklet (CRF Set) of all protocol forms is available for review.
3. In a separate file,
 - a. indicate specifically the form names and question numbers required,
OR
 - b. highlight the data elements required on the PDF form.

This information must be provided in electronic format. DARs requesting clinical data will be considered incomplete unless this information is provided.

ACRIN provides only "raw" data, that is, data collected on protocol case report forms and stored in the ACRIN main database. Any derivations are the sole responsibility of the requester.

Please note that data will be de-identified by removing/redacting all 18 data elements specified in the HIPAA Privacy Rule (http://privacyruleandresearch.nih.gov/pr_08.asp).

CRF Data Step 2: Specify the case selection algorithm.

Specify the criteria and algorithm which the IDEAS Study Biostatistics Center should use to select cases and data needed for your request. These criteria and the resulting algorithm must be defined using identification codes and data elements from the case report forms. Please be explicit as this algorithm will be used should this application be approved.

For example, if the request is for data from a subset of participants, the application should specify that:

- (a) data elements X, Y, Z from forms A, B, C should be used to identify cases, and
- (b) these data should be processed according to an explicit algorithm you provide below.
